We are so very grateful for our audience at The Rogue. You are the reason for our existence.

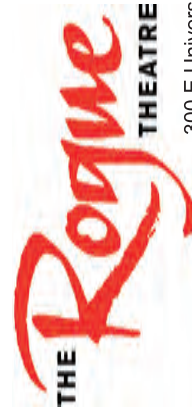

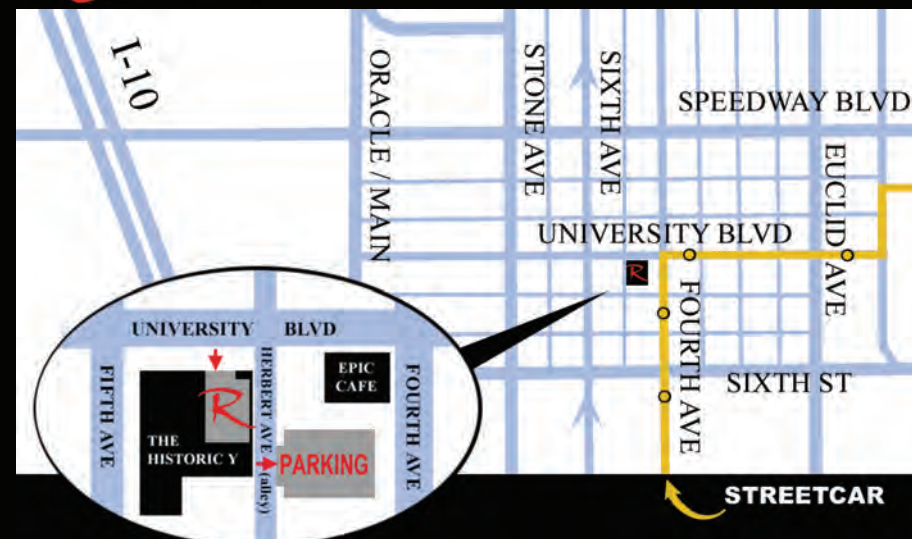
